During the summer, we offer a six week summer program. The summer program will commence on Monday, July 18th and will end on Friday, August 26th. We encourage all new students to enroll in summer program as it provides a wonderful preparation for the fall program. The summer curriculum is designed to provide a balance of academic enrichment, fine arts, physical education, and outdoor activities. We will continue with the basic Montessori curriculum in the language, math and sensorial areas while keeping in mind that children are on vacation and fun is a must. Exploring Nature



The children will have an opportunity to explore various aspects of nature. This summer adventure will involve learning about plants, trees, birds, worms, bugs and many more. Children will get hands on education in planting, watering, weeding, and general care of plants in our garden.

They will explore, experiment, and discover the possibilities of how using collage, recycled materials, and nature items can help with individual expressions which result in creative concepts.

It is exciting for the children to create beautiful designs with the process of tie dying. We will be making shirts using simple tools of this technique.

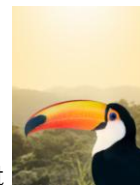
- August 8-August 12

The children will have hands on learning with fresh foods from different parts of the world. They will explore a variety of foods using their senses and will also learn about nutrition and food history.

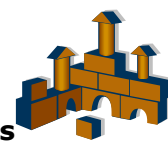
- August 15- August 19
